Band Camp and Rehearsal General Information

Daily Required Supplies

Your student will need:

- An insulated half-gallon+ water jug
- Lunch and snacks
- Sunscreen - SPF 30 or higher
- **Deodorant**
- Shorts, light colored t-shirts, and athletic shoes. Students will not be allowed onto the field in sandals.
- A towel (for putting down on the asphalt during warmups)
- Hat and sunglasses
- Pencil(s) to make rehearsal markings
- Brass/Woodwind/Percussion students are also required to have a binder with page protectors for music and handouts

Drop off Times

On time is late. The students must be in their designated practice space with their instrument/equipment, ready to go by the time rehearsal starts. Please plan on having your student at the site **at least 15 minutes before** the start of rehearsal.

Pick up Times

If practice ends at 7:00pm, the band still needs to put gear away. Do not be surprised if 7:00pm is really 7:15pm! Please make sure to pick up your student no later than half an hour after the determined end time.
